FOR OPENERS

- Virginia (5-1) meets SMU (5-1) for the first time in the semifinals of the 2013 Corpus Christi Challenge.
- The Cavaliers defeated Liberty (75-53) and Hampton (69-40) in the first and second rounds, while SMU defeated Arkansas Pine-Bluff (87-61) and Sam Houston State (72-53).
- Virginia will meet Texas A&M (6-0) or Missouri State (5-0) in the final round on Saturday, Nov. 30 at 6:30 or 9 p.m.
- UVa is 48-19 against non-conference opponents during the Tony Bennett era.
- The Cavaliers lead the nation in scoring defense at 48.7 points per game.
- Virginia is outscoring opponents 168-73 in bench points, averaging 28 per game.
- UVa's average margin of victory is 21.8 points.
- Tony Bennett recorded his 150th career win against Hampton (11/26/13).

VIRGINIA RECEIVING VOTES IN LATEST NATIONAL POLLS

- UVa received votes in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012, when they were No. 24 in the AP poll.

VIRGINIA VS. SMU, TEXAS A&M AND MISSOURI STATE

- Virginia and SMU meet for the first time.
- The Cavaliers would play Missouri State for the first time and are 0-1 vs. Texas A&M, dropping a 60-59 decison on Dec. 29, 1962, in Jonesboro, Arkansas.

AGAINST THE AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

- SMU is the lone team from the American Athletic Conference on Virginia's 2013-14 schedule.
- Virginia has an 18-18 record against current AAC members (5-3 vs. Louisville, 3-0 vs. Rutgers, 3-2 vs. Temple, 3-3 vs. Houston, 2-6 vs. UCONN, 1-1 vs. South Florida and 1-3 vs. Cincinatti.

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia defeated Hampton, 69-40, on Nov. 26 at JPJ.
- Joe Harris had a season-high 20 points on 7-of-7 shooting, including 4-of-4 from 3-point range.
- Justin Anderson added 12 points, four rebounds and three blocks off the bench.
- UVa went 8-of-12 from 3-point range for a season-high 66.7 percent and had a season-high 10 steals.
- Virginia dominated the glass for the sixth straight game, outrebounding the Pirates 42-21.

HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell lead the Cavaliers into action this season.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris tallied a career-high 36 points against Duke and Mitchell had a team-leading 12 double-doubles.

- Harris earned All-ACC first-team honors, while Mitchell was named to the third team.
- Harris ranks 25th on UVa's all-time scoring list with 1,304 points and Mitchell has grabbed 561 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 11.5 points and 4.2 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 7.0 points and 4.3 rebounds.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 81-54 mark in five seasons at UVa and 150-87 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVa's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.

EMBRACE THE PACE

• As of Nov. 27, the Cavaliers rank in the top eight nationally in 10 defensive categories: points per game (1st), rebounds per game (1st), rebound percentage (2nd), points per possession (4th), possessions per 40 minutes (4th), offensive rebounds per game (5th), assists per game (6th), shooting percentage (6th), defensive rebounds per game (8th) and true shoot-

ing percentage (8th).

• Virginia has held all six of its opponents below 42 percent shooting from the floor

and opponents are shooting 34.6 percent from the floor and 31.9 percent (38-for-119) from 3-point range overall.

• Virginia has limited JMU (2), VCU (3), Davidson (2), Navy (5) and Liberty (2), Hampton (0) to a combined 14 fast break points.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in each of its first six games.
- The Cavaliers rank second nationally in rebound percentage at 60.3 percent and are enjoying a +15.3 average rebound margin per game.
- Darion Atkins (6.3), Mike Tobey (5.7), Justin Anderson (5.2), Malcolm Brogdon (4.7), Akil Mitchell (4.3) and Joe Harris (4.2) are each averaging four or more rebounds per game.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- Virginia has outscored its opponents in the paint in five of six games and 202-108 overall.
- Virginia has scored 51 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVa in scoring in four of six games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy and 13 vs. Liberty and Tobey 18 vs. Davidson).

MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ACTION

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging 11.0 points and a team-leading 1.4 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 55.3 percent (26-of-47) from the floor and a team-best 50 percent (8-of-16) from 3-point range.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and matched his career high with three 3-pointers against JMU (11/8/13).
- Brogdon tallied a career-best four consecutive games of double figures scoring from Nov. 12-23.
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...DOES IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey is becoming Virginia's go-to man, averaging career bests in points (8.7), rebounds (5.7) and blocks (1.2) this season.
- Tobey is also displaying his scoring touch, shooting 53.5 percent (23-of-43) from the floor.
- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey moved into the starting lineup on Nov. 19 and has scored in double figures in three of six games.

AG MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER

- Redshirt sophomore transfer Anthony Gill made his Virginia debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.
- Gill has led UVa in scoring in three games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), a career-high 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13) and 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13).
- Gill is shooting a sizzling 72.7 percent from the floor (24-of-33) and averaging 9.3 points and 3.0 rebounds per game this season.
- Gill averaged 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as a freshman for South Carolina in 2011-12.

ANDERSON ACCOMPLISHES RARE FEAT

- Sophomore Justin Anderson was one of two players in NCAA Divison I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.
- Anderson tallied 24 points, six rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in Virginia's season-ending 75-64 loss to lowa (3/27/13), while Ammons had 21 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers vs. FIU.
- Anderson, who started the first two games, had 12 points and eight rebounds off the bench vs. Davidson (11/16/13).
- He added 12 points, four rebounds and three blocks vs. Hampton (11/26/13).

LONDON CALLING

- Freshman London Perrantes quickly joined the UVa starting lineup, making his first collegiate start in UVa's third game vs. Davidson (11/16/13).
- Perrantes is averaging 2.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and a team-leading 3.8 assists in 26.2 minutes per game.
- In his first career start, Perrantes had five points, five assists and no turnovers in a team-high 32 minutes vs. Davidson (11/16/13).
- Perrantes, who has a 3.8 assists to turnover ratio, added a season-high six assists against Liberty (11/23/13).

STITH, WILKINS AND SALT INK LETTERS OF INTENT WITH CAVALIERS

- Tony Bennett announced the signings of center Jack Salt (Auckland, New Zealand/Westlake Boys High School), guard B.J. Stith (Lawrenceville, Va./Oak Hill Academy) and forward Isaiah Wilkins (Lilburn, Ga./Greater Atlanta Christian School) to National Letters of Intent.
- The 6-10, 240-pound Salt tallied 14 points and 16 rebounds as the Westlake Boys High School Premier Team recently defended its New Zealand School Boys AA title.
- The 6-5, 205-pound Stith helped lead Brunswick High School to three straight Virginia High School League Division 3 State titles prior to enrolling at Oak Hill Academy for the 2013-14 season. Stith was named all-state and all-region after averaging 16 points, six rebounds and six assists per game to lead the 2013 state champion Bulldogs. Stith, who is ranked No. 48 on Rivals.com's 2014 Prospect Ranking list, is the son of former Virginia star and NBA player Bryant Stith.
- The 6-8, 205-pound Wilkins averaged 17 points and eight rebounds per game for Greater Atlanta Christian School in 2012-13. Wilkins led Greater Christian to the Georgia AA State championship and was named the AA State Player of the Year and Region 6-AA Player of the Year.

ABOUT THE 2013-14 SCHEDULE

- Six of Virginia's opponents were ranked in the preseason polls (Duke, Syracuse, North Carolina, VCU, Wisconsin and Notre Dame), while three (Tennessee, Pittsburgh and Boston College) received votes.
- Twelve opponents (JMU, VCU, Davidson, Liberty, Wisconsin, NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, Miami and Syracuse) earned 2013 NCAA Tournament berths, while four (Norfolk State, Tennessee, Florida State and Maryland) participated in the National Invitation Tournament and two (Northern Iowa and Green Bay) in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 4TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked seventh and finished tied for fourth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Syracuse, North Carolina, UVa, Notre Dame, Pitt, Maryland, Boston College, Florida State, NC State, Georgia Tech, Miami, Wake Forest, Clemson and Virginia Tech.

VIRGINIA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 7-14 against ranked opponents, including a 1-6 mark vs. top five opponents, in the Tony Bennett era.
- Virginia is 122-310 vs. ranked opponents, including a 24-119 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- The Cavaliers are 1-26 vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
- The Cavaliers are 0-1 vs. ranked opponents this season, losing 59-56 to No. 14 VCU.

HARRIS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Joe Harris is one of five players named Preseason All-ACC.
- Joining Harris on the preseason All-ACC team were C.J. Fair (Syracuse), Rodney Hood (Duke), Jabari Parker (Duke) and Jerian Grant (Notre Dame). Fair was the pick for Preseason ACC Player of the Year and Parker was named Preseason ACC Rookie of the Year.

HARRIS ONE OF 15 ON ROBERTSON WATCH LIST

- Joe Harris is one of 15 players on the preseason Oscar Robertson Watch List, honoring the nation's NCAA Division I Player of the Year.
- Joining Harris on the Robertson watch list were Jahii Carson (Arizona State), Aaron Craft (Ohio State), C. J. PRESS CREDENTIALS

We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.
