FOR OPENERS

- Virginia (7-1) meets No. 8 Wisconsin (8-0) in the 15th annual Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett (Green Bay) is a Wisconsin native, who starred at Green Bay (1988-92) and coached at Wisconsin for four seasons (1999-2000) under his father, Dick Bennett, Brad Soderberg and current Wisconsin head coach Bo Ryan.
- Virginia is 8-5 in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, while Wisconsin is 6-8.
- The Cavaliers' Corpus Christi Challenge title was their first tournament championship in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVa is 50-19 against non-conference opponents during Bennett's five seasons.
- The Cavaliers rank third in the nation in scoring defense at 53.5 points per game.
- Virginia is outscoring opponents 250-138 in bench points, averaging 31.3 per game.
- Virginia is 7-14 vs. ranked opponents under Bennett.

VIRGINIA RECEIVING VOTES IN LATEST NATIONAL POLLS

- UVa received votes in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012, when they were No. 24 in the AP poll.

AGAINST THE BIG TEN CONFERENCE

- Virginia is 20-20 all-time vs. current Big Ten Conference opponents (5-2 vs. Minnesota, 5-3 vs. Penn State, 3-0 vs. Northwestern, 2-1 vs. Wisconsin, 2-2 vs. Michigan, 1-1 vs. Purdue, 1-2 vs. Indiana, 1-3 vs. Ohio State, 0-3 vs. Michigan State, 0-1 vs. Nebraska and 0-2 vs. Iowa).
- UVa is the only ACC team to win in each of the last three ACC/Big Ten Challenges.

ALL-TIME IN THE ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

- Virginia meets Wisconsin for the second straight year in the Challenge after claiming a 60-54 win over Wisconsin in Madison.
- The Cavaliers have an ACC-high, three-game winning streak in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- UVa is 8-5 in the Challenge, including a 5-1 mark in Charlottesville.
- The ACC won the Commissioner's Cup the first 10 years of the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, but the Big Ten has won the cup the last three years.

- Virginia captured the Corpus Christi Challenge championship with an 83-63 win over Missouri State on Nov. 30.
- Justin Anderson tallied a season-high 23 points and tournament MVP Joe Harris scored 15 points and Mike Tobey and Malcolm Brogdon reached double figures with 14 and 13 points, respectively.
- Anthony Gill added eight points and eight rebounds, joining Harris and Anderson on the all-tournament team.
- UVa shot 56.6 percent (30-of-53) and drilled nine 3-pointers in the win.

NOTEWORTHY

- Virginia has made eight or more 3-pointers in each of its last four games, shooting 51.4% (36-of-70) from downtown during that span.
- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in two of eight games.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory is 18.9 points.

MORE WISCONSIN TIES

- Virginia graduate manager Mark Vershaw, who played collegiately at Wisconsin from 1997-2001 for head coaches Dick Bennett and Brad Soderberg, was the leading scorer on the Badgers' 2000 Final Four squad.
- Freshman forward Evan Nolte was born in Milwaukee, Wis.

HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell lead the Cavaliers into action this season.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris ranks 24th on UVa's all-time scoring list with 1,354 points and Mitchell has grabbed 561 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 12.4 points and 3.7 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 6.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- Harris is shooting 55.2 percent (13-of-23) from 3-point range this season, including 11-of-12 in the last three games.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 83-54 mark in five seasons at UVa and 152-87 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVa's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in seven of eight games.
- The Cavaliers rank fourth nationally in rebound percentage at 58.9 percent and are enjoying a +13 average rebound margin per game.
- Mike Tobey (5.1), Darion Atkins (5.0), Akil Mitchell (5.0), Malcolm Brogdon (4.9), Justin Anderson (4.3) and Anthony Gill (4.1) are each averaging four or more rebounds per game.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- UVa has outscored its opponents in the paint in six of eight games and 246-146 overall.
- Virginia has scored 44 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVa in scoring in five of eight games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Tobey 18 vs. Davidson).

MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ACTION

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging 10.8 points and a team-leading 1.3 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 50.8 percent (30-of-59) from the floor, 43.5 percent (10-of-23) from 3-point range and a team-leading 88.9 percent (16-of-18) from the free throw line.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and matched his career high with three 3-pointers against JMU (11/8/13).
- Brogdon tallied a career-best four consecutive games of double figures scoring from Nov. 12-23.
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...DOES IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey is becoming Virginia's go-to man, averaging career bests in points (8.6), rebounds (5.1) and blocks (1.0) this season.
- Tobey is also displaying his scoring touch, shooting 51.9 percent (28-of-54) from the floor.

- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey, who has started four games, has scored in double figures in four of eight games.

AG MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER

- Redshirt sophomore Anthony Gill made his UVa debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.
- Gill has led UVa in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Gill, who earned Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament honors, is shooting a sizzling 68.6 percent from the floor (33-of-48) and averaging 10.4 points and 4.1 rebounds per game this season.
- Gill averaged 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as a freshman for South Carolina in 2011-12.

ANDERSON GIVES VIRGINIA A LIFT OFF THE BENCH

- Sophomore Justin Anderson was one of two players in NCAA Divison I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.
- Anderson tallied 24 points, six rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in Virginia's season-ending 75-64 loss to lowa (3/27/13), while Ammons had 21 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers vs. FIU.
- Anderson, who started the first two games, is averaging 10 points per game in six games off the bench.
- He had a season-high 23 points (10-of-13 shooting) vs. Missouri State and added 12-point efforts vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and Hampton (11/26/13).
- Anderson earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors.

LONDON CALLING

- Freshman London Perrantes joined the UVa starting lineup vs. Davidson (11/16/13).
- Perrantes is averaging 2.8 points, 2.1 rebounds and a team-leading 3.5 assists in 26.2 minutes per game.
- Perrantes had a season-high nine points on 3-of-3 shooting from 3-point range vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Perrantes, who has a 4.0 assists to turnover ratio, added a season-high six assists against Liberty (11/23/13) and Missouri State (11/30/13).

ABOUT THE 2013-14 SCHEDULE

- Six of Virginia's opponents were ranked in the preseason polls (Duke, Syracuse, North Carolina, VCU, Wisconsin and Notre Dame), while three (Tennessee, Pittsburgh and Boston College) received votes.
- Twelve opponents (JMU, VCU, Davidson, Liberty, Wisconsin, NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, Miami and Syracuse) earned 2013 NCAA Tournament berths, while four (Norfolk State, Tennessee, Florida State and Maryland) participated in the National Invitation Tournament and two (Northern Iowa and Green Bay) in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 4TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- UVa, who was picked seventh and tied for fourth last season, has finished at or higher than its predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Syracuse, North Carolina, UVa, Notre Dame, Pitt, Maryland, Boston College, Florida State, NC State, Georgia Tech, Miami, Wake Forest, Clemson and Virginia Tech.

Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.
