- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett (Green Bay) is a Wisconsin native, who starred at Green Bay (1988-92) and coached at Wisconsin for four seasons (1999-2000) under his father, Dick Bennett, Brad Soderberg and current Wisconsin head coach Bo Ryan.
- Virginia is 8-5 in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, while Wisconsin is 6-8.
- The Cavaliers' Corpus Christi Challenge title was their first tournament championship in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVa is 50-19 against non-conference opponents during Bennett's five seasons.
- The Cavaliers rank third in the nation in scoring defense at 53.5 points per game.
- Virginia is outscoring opponents $250-138$ in bench points, averaging 31.3 per game.
- Virginia is $7-14$ vs. ranked opponents under Bennett.


## VIRGINIA RECEIVING VOTES IN LATEST NATIONAL POLLS

- UVa received votes in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012, when they were No. 24 in the AP poll.

## ALL-TIME IN THE ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

- Virginia meets Wisconsin for the second straight year in the Challenge after claiming a 60-54 win over Wisconsin in Madison.
-The Cavaliers have an ACC-high, three-game winning streak in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- UVa is 8-5 in the Challenge, including a 5-1 mark in Charlottesville.
-The ACC won the Commissioner's Cup the first 10 years of the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, but the Big Ten has won the cup the last three years.


## ALL-TIME VS. WISCONSIN

- UVa is 2-1 all-time vs. Wisconsin.
- Joe Harris (22 points) and Akil Mitchell (11 points, 10 rebounds) and Darion Atkins (14 points, 7 rebounds) led Virginia in last season's 60-54 win at Wisconsin.
- Wisconsin defeated Virginia 66-56 at the 1999 Top of the World Classic in Fairbanks, Alaska.
- Virginia defeated Wisconsin, 86-78, at the Milwaukee Classic during the 1974-75 season in Milwaukee, Wis.

## LAST TIME OUT

-Virginia captured the Corpus Christi Challenge championship with an 83-63 win over Missouri State on Nov. 30.

- Justin Anderson tallied a season-high 23 points and tournament MVP Joe Harris scored 15 points and Mike Tobey and Malcolm Brogdon reached double figures with 14 and 13 points, respectively.
- Anthony Gill added eight points and eight rebounds, joining Harris and Anderson on the all-tournament team.
- UVa shot 56.6 percent (30-of-53) and drilled nine 3-pointers in the win.


## NOTEWORTHY

- Virginia has made eight or more 3-pointers in each of its last four games, shooting $51.4 \%$ (36-of-70) from downtown during that span.
- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in two of eight games.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory is 18.9 points.


## MORE WISCONSIN TIES

- Virginia graduate manager Mark Vershaw, who played collegiately at Wisconsin from 1997-2001 for head coaches Dick Bennett and Brad Soderberg, was the leading scorer on the Badgers' 2000 Final Four squad.
- Freshman forward Evan Nolte was born in Milwaukee, Wis.


## HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell lead the Cavaliers into action this season.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris ranks 24th on UVa's all-time scoring list with 1,354 points and Mitchell has grabbed 561 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 12.4 points and 3.7 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 6.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- Harris is shooting 55.2 percent (13-of-23) from 3-point range this season, including 11-of-12 in the last three games.


## VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 83-54 mark in five seasons at UVa and 152-87 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last four seasons ( 15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVa's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.


## EMBRACE THE PACE

- As of Dec. 2, the Cavaliers rank in the top nine nationally in seven defensive categories: rebounds per game (1st), offensive rebounds percentage (2nd), points per game (3rd), offensive rebounds per game (3rd), rebound percentage (5th), points per possession (5th) and defensive rebounds per game (9th).
-Virginia has held all eight of its opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 37.2 percent (17th nationally) from the floor and 33.8 percent (53-for-157) from 3-point range overall.
- Virginia has limited JMU (2), VCU (3), Davidson (2), Navy (5) and Liberty (2), Hampton (0), SMU (2) and Missouri State (2) to a combined 18 fast break points.

- Brogdon is averaging 10.8 points and a team-leading 1.3 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 50.8 percent (30-of-59) from the floor, 43.5 percent (10-of-23) from 3-point range and a team-leading 88.9 percent (16-of-18) from the free throw line.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and matched his career high with three 3-pointers against JMU (11/8/13).

- Gill has led UVa in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Gill, who earned Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament honors, is shooting a sizzling 68.6 percent from the floor (33-of-48) and averaging

- Sophomore Justin Anderson was one of two players in NCAA Divison I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.
- Anderson tallied 24 points, six rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in Virginia's season-ending 75-64 loss to lowa (3/27/13), while Ammons had 21 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers vs. FIU.
- Anderson, who started the first two games, is averaging 10 points per game in six games off the bench.
- He had a season-high 23 points (10-of-13 shooting) vs. Missouri State and added 12-point efforts vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and Hampton
(11/26/13).
- Anderson earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors.

- Freshman London Perrantes joined the UVa starting lineup vs. Davidson (11/16/13).
- Perrantes is averaging 2.8 points, 2.1 rebounds and a team-leading 3.5 assists in 26.2 minutes per game.
- Perrantes had a season-high nine points on 3-of-3 shooting from 3-point range vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Perrantes, who has a 4.0 assists to turnover ratio, added a season-high six assists against Liberty (11/23/13) and Missouri State (11/30/13).

## PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media members interested in obtaining season or game credentials should contact Erich Bacher via email at bacher@virginia.edu, office phone (434) 982-5530 or cell phone (720) 318-5538. We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

## PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

## PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

## INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

## POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

## RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

## GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game.
