### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia's 5-1 start in the ACC is its best since starting 5-1 in 1994-95.
- Virginia seeks its first 6-1 start in the ACC since 1982-83 (Ralph Sampson's senior season).
- The margin of victory in each of the Cavaliers' first five ACC wins was at least 10 points, for the first time in school history.
- As of Jan. 23, Virginia is tied for second in the ACC at 5-1 and Virginia Tech is tied for 14th at 1-5.
- The Cavaliers rank fifth in the nation in scoring defense at 56.8 points per game.

### COACHES VS. CANCER SUITS AND SNEAKERS™ AWARENESS WEEKEND

- The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of The Coaches vs. Cancer Suits And Sneakers™ Awareness Weekend, celebrated Jan. 24-26.
- The nationwide event unites coaches across the country to raise awareness about the fight against cancer, and promote the American Cancer Society as a place for help and support.
- On Saturday, the Virginia and Virginia Tech coaching staffs will wear sneakers with their game attire as a visible reminder about the importance of nutrition and physical activity in reducing one's cancer risk.

### ALL-TIME AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 84-53 all-time vs. Virginia Tech in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 5-3 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.
- The Cavaliers are 34-12, including a 4-3 mark at John Paul Jones Arena, against the Hokies in Charlottesville.
- The Cavaliers have won three straight games against Virginia Tech and five of the last six contests in the series.
- Virginia posted a two-game sweep against Virginia Tech last season (74-58 win in Blacksburg and 73-55 win in Charlottesville).
- Virginia is 4-1 against Virginia Tech in its last five games and 6-4 in its last 10.

### LAST TIME VS. THE HOKIES

- Joe Harris scored 26 points and Virginia held national scoring leader Erick Green (22 points) without a field goal into the second half, sweeping the season series against Virginia Tech with a 73-55 win on Feb. 12, 2013.
- Harris matched his career high with five 3-pointers, all in the first half, and Akil Mitchell added 17 points for the Cavaliers.
- Virginia trailed 18-17 until Teven Jones made a 3-pointer with 10:31 to go in the first half, sparking a half-ending 19-5 run.
- UVa held Virginia Tech to 34.6 percent (18-of-52) shooting from the field, and 32 percent (8-of-25) on 3s.

### AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH

- Since the 1999-2000 season, Virginia has a 49-13 record against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- The Cavaliers are 4-1 against in-state teams this season, defeating James Madison (61-41), Liberty (75-53), Hampton (69-40) and Norfolk State (66-56) and losing to VCU (59-56).

### VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- For the second consecutive week, UVa is receiving votes in both national polls.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for the first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris each scored 16 points as Virginia defeated North Carolina, 76-61, Monday night.
- The Cavaliers, who led by 23 points in the second half, also received 13 points from Justin Anderson and eight points and eight rebounds from Anthony Gill.
- Kennedy Meeks scored 15 points and James Michael McAdoo had 11 for North Carolina.
- Virginia made eight 3-pointers and turned 11 North Carolina turnovers into 17 points.
- London Perrantes had eight points (2-of-2 on 3-pointers), a career-best nine assists, two steals and only one turnover.

**ALL-TIME VS. ACC OPPONENTS**

- Virginia is 529-692 all-time against current ACC members (9-7 vs. Boston College, 69-52 vs. Clemson, 84-53 vs. Virginia Tech, 49-116 vs. Duke, 20-22 vs. Florida State, 35-39 vs. Georgia Tech, 73-106 vs. Maryland, 5-10 vs. Miami, 51-128 vs. UNC, 60-82 vs. NC State, 5-1 vs. Notre Dame, 7-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 1-3 vs. Syracuse and 61-70 vs. Wake Forest).

**TEAM NOTES**

- Virginia is 13-1 when leading at the half and 14-2 when opponents shoot less than 50 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers lead the ACC in scoring margin during league play at +14.8.
- UVA is third in the ACC in scoring offense at 71.8 points per game, marking its highest ACC average under Tony Bennett (63.9 ppg in 2012-13).
- Virginia has committed nine or less turnovers in each of its last four games.
- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in eight of 19 games and its 65.6 percent free throw percentage is its lowest since shooting 65.8 percent in 2002-03.
- The Cavaliers are 10-1 with their current starting lineup of London Perrantes, Malcolm Brogdon, Joe Harris, Akil Mitchell and Mike Tobey.
- The Cavaliers have used seven different starting lineups, including four guards (London Perrantes, Joe Harris, Justin Anderson, Malcolm Brogdon) and forward Darion Atkins against Norfolk State (12/23/13).
- Virginia captured the Corpus Christi Challenge earlier this season with wins over Liberty, Hampton, SMU and Missouri State.

**PLAYER NOTES**

- Joe Harris leads all active ACC players with 224 career 3-point field goals.
- Harris' 11.6 scoring average leads the team and would be the lowest UVA team scoring leader in 61 seasons of ACC action.
- Malcolm Brogdon (46-of-51, 90.2 percent) and London Perrantes (26-of-32, 81.3 percent) are a combined 72-of-83 (86.7 percent) from the free throw line, while the rest of the team is 220-for-362 (60.7 percent).

**HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION**

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell are Virginia's team leaders.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris is 18th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,475 points and Mitchell ranks 14th with 666 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 11.6 points and 3.4 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 6.7 points and 6.7 rebounds.
- Harris is shooting 43.4 percent (33-of-76) from 3-point range this season and Mitchell has grabbed 10 or more rebounds in three games.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 90-58 mark in five seasons at UVA and 159-91 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVA's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVA's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

**EMBRACE THE PACE**

- As of Jan. 23, the Cavaliers rank in the top 15 nationally in seven defensive categories: points per game (5th), points per possession (9th), offensive rebound percentage (10th), offensive rebounds per game (12th), rebounds per game (13th), field goal percentage (13th) and rebound percentage (15th).
- Virginia has held 17 of its 19 opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 38 percent (13th nationally) from the floor and 32.9 percent from 3-point range overall.
- Virginia has limited its opponents to a combined 65 fast break points for an average of 3.4 per game.

**CLEANING THE GLASS**

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in 14 of 19 games.
- The Cavaliers rank 14th nationally in rebound percentage at 55 percent and are enjoying a +7.3 average rebound margin per game.
- Akil Mitchell (6.7), Malcolm Brogdon (5.2), Mike Tobey (4.6), Justin Anderson (3.9), Anthony Gill (3.9), Joe Harris (3.4) and Darion Atkins (3.1) are each averaging three or more rebounds per game.

**PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE**

- UVA has outscored its opponents in the paint in 14 of 19 games and 548-406 overall.
- Virginia has scored 43 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVA in scoring in seven of 19 games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU; Tobey 18 vs. Davidson and 16 at NC State; and Anderson 16 at Florida State).

**OFF THE BENCH**

- Virginia is outscoring opponents 475-334 in bench points, averaging 25 per game.
- A bench player has led the team in scoring in six games (Tobey 18 vs. Davidson, Gill 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Anderson 23 vs. Missouri State and 16 at Florida State).

## 2013-14 Opponents in Bold

### ANDERSON PROVING HIS WORTH AS A SIXTH MAN

- Justin Anderson, who has reached double figures in scoring in each of the last three games, is proving to be a valuable sixth man for UVa.
- Anderson, who has led UVa in scoring in five games, is averaging 9.9 points and 3.9 rebounds per game.
- He reached double figures in six consecutive games (Dec. 7-Jan. 8) and has led the team in scoring in five games (23 points vs. Missouri State, 16 vs. Northern Iowa, 14 points vs. Norfolk State, 11 at Tennessee and 16 at Florida State).
- Anderson also earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors after averaging 12 points in four wins during the tournament.
- He was one of two players in NCAA Division I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.

### MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging 11.1 points, 5.2 rebounds and a team-leading 1.4 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 34.4 percent (22-of-64) from 3-point range and a team-leading 90.2 percent (46-of-51) from the free throw line.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13), Green Bay (12/7/13) and Duke (1/13/14) and matched his career high with three 3-pointers against JMU (11/8/13) and Green Bay.
- Brogdon has tallied a career-best six consecutive games of double figures scoring from Jan. 4-20.
- In six ACC games, Brogdon ranks first in free throw percentage (89.5%), fourth in steals (1.83 spg), seventh in field goal percentage (47.1%) and 13th in scoring (14.5 ppg).
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

### TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...CAN DO IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey has shown the ability to be Virginia's go-to man, averaging 7.4 points, 4.6 rebounds and a team-leading 1.2 blocks per game.
- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and ACC high 16 at NC State (1/11/14) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey, who is tied for ninth in the ACC in offensive rebounds per game at 2.53, has started 10 games and scored in double figures seven times.

### AG MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER

- Redshirt sophomore Anthony Gill made his UVa debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.
- Gill has led UVa in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Gill, who earned Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament honors, is shooting 63.2 percent from the floor (55-of-87) and averaging 7.8 points and 3.9 rebounds per game this season.
- He has scored in double figures in six games.
- Gill averaged 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as a freshman for South Carolina in 2011-12.

### LONDON CALLING

- Freshman London Perrantes has made an immediate impact during his freshman campaign at UVa.
- Perrantes, who has started 15 games, is averaging 4.5 points, 2.1 rebounds and a team-leading 3.7 assists per game.
- Perrantes had a career-high 14 points at Florida State (1/4/14) and career-best nine assists vs. North Carolina (1/20/14).
- Perrantes, who ranks third in the ACC with a 3.0 assists to turnover ratio, has tallied five or more assists in eight games.

You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

### PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

### PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

### INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

### POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

### RADIO
