#### **FOR OPENERS**

- Virginia opens its 61st season of ACC action.
- The Cavaliers are 4-0 in ACC openers under head coach Tony Bennett and 25-35 all-time.
- · Virginia looks to win its sixth consecutive ACC opener.
- The Cavaliers rank fifth in the nation in scoring defense at 56.7 points per game.

#### **ALL-TIME AGAINST FLORIDA STATE**

- Virginia is 18-22 vs. Florida State in the series that dates back to 1991-92.
- The Cavaliers are 0-10 in their last 10 games at Florida State and are 6-14 against the Seminoles in Tallahassee.
- UVa's last win at Florida State was on Feb. 17, 2001 (69-66).
- UVa is 2-8 in its last 10 games against the Seminoles.
- The Cavaliers posted a 56-36 win and 53-51 loss against Florida State last season.

#### **LAST TIME VS. FLORIDA STATE**

- Florida State edged Virginia, 53-51, as Michael Snaer hit the game-winning shot with four seconds remaining.
- Virginia trailed 47-36 before Justin Anderson's dunk ignited a 15-3 run with 6:01 remaining.
- Akil Mitchell had 15 points and a game-high 12 rebounds and Joe Harris added 12 points for Virginia.
- Okaro White led the Seminoles with 17 points, while Snaer finished with 14 and Kiel Turpin added 11.

#### **SUNSHINE STATE NOT SO SUNNY FOR VIRGINIA**

- UVa has a 17-game losing streak in Florida (10 at Florida State, 5 at Miami, 1 at South Florida and 1 in the ACC Tournament in Tampa).
- The Cavaliers dropped a pair of games last season in Florida to Miami (54-50) and Florida State (53-51).
- Virginia's last win in the Sunshine State was a 69-66 decision at Florida State on Feb. 17, 2001.

#### **VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS**

- For the second straight week, UVa is neither ranked nor receiving votes in either national poll.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for the first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012, when they were No. 24 in the AP poll.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Virginia lost 87-52 at Tennessee on Dec. 30, marking the second-largest loss during Tony Bennett's five seasons at Virginia.
- Virginia allowed a trio of 20-point scorers (Jordan McRae 21, Josh Richardson 20, Jarnell Stokes 20) for the first time since Nov. 25, 2008 vs. Liberty (Seth Curry 26, Kyle Ohman 26 and Anthony Smith 21).
- UVa associate head coach Ritchie McKay was the head coach of the 2008-09 Liberty team.
- Justin Anderson led the Cavaliers in scoring for the third straight game with 11 points.

#### **ALL-TIME VS. ACC OPPONENTS**

• Virginia is 523-688 all-time against current ACC members (9-7 vs. Boston College, 69-52 vs. Clemson, 84-53 vs. Virginia Tech, 49-115 vs. Duke, 18-22 vs. Florida State, 35-39 vs. Georgia Tech, 73-106 vs. Maryland, 5-10 vs. Miami, 50-128 vs. UNC, 59-82 vs. NC State, 5-1 vs. Notre Dame, 7-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 0-0 vs. Syracuse and 60-70 vs. Wake Forest.)

#### **NOTEWORTHY**

- Virginia is 0-2 in true road games this season, losing 75-72 at Green Bay and 87-52 at Tennessee.
- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in five of 12 games, including a season-high 82.4 percent (14-of-17) at Tennes-see (12/30/13).
- Malcolm Brogdon (29-of-32, 90.6 percent) and London Perrantes (18-of-21, 85.7 percent) are a combined 47-for-53 (88.7 percent) from the free throw line, while the rest of the team is 145-for-240 (60.4 percent).
- The Cavaliers have used six different starting lineups, including four guards (London Perrantes, Joe Harris, Justin Anderson, Malcolm Brogdon) and forward Darion Atkins against Norfolk State (12/23/13).

#### HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell are Virginia's team leaders.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris ranks 23rd on UVa's all-time scoring list with 1,399 points and Mitchell ranks 18th with 610 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 11.1 points and 3.8 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 6.1 points and 5.5 rebounds.
- Harris is shooting 38.8 percent (19-of-49) from 3-point range this season.

#### VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 85-57 mark in five seasons at UVa and 154-90 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVa's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.

#### **EMBRACE THE PACE**

• As of Dec. 31, the Cavaliers rank in the top 15 nationally in seven defensive categories: possessions per 40 minutes (3rd), points per game (5th), rebounds per game (5th), offensive rebounding percentage (12th), points per possession (12th) and rebound percentage (14th).

- Virginia has held 11 of its 13 opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 38.0 percent (18th nationally) from the floor and 33.3 percent from 3-point range overall.
- Virginia has limited JMU (2), VCU (3), Davidson (2), Navy (5) and Liberty (2), Hampton (0), SMU (2), Missouri State (2), Wisconsin (2), Green Bay (11), Northern Iowa (7), Norfolk State (4) and Tennessee (9) to a combined 51 fast break points.

#### **CLEANING THE GLASS**

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in 10 of 13 games.
- The Cavaliers rank 14th nationally in rebound percentage at 55.5 percent and are enjoying a +8.5 average rebound margin per game.
- Akil Mitchell (5.5), Malcolm Brogdon (5.4), Mike Tobey (4.8), Justin Anderson (4.4), Joe Harris (3.8) and Darion Atkins (3.8) are each averaging three or more rebounds per game.

#### PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- UVa has outscored its opponents in the paint in nine of 13 games and 362-270 overall.
- Virginia has scored 43 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVa in scoring in five of 13 games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Tobey 18 vs. Davidson).

#### OFF THE BENCH

- Virginia is outscoring opponents 341-183 in bench points, averaging 26.2 per game.
- A bench player has led the team in scoring in five games (Tobey 18 vs. Davidson, Gill 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Anderson 23 vs. Missouri State).

#### ANDERSON PROVING HIS WORTH

- Sophomore Justin Anderson is proving to be a valuable all-around player for Virginia.
- Anderson, who has started and led UVa in scoring in each of the last three games, is averaging 9.3 points and 4.4 rebounds per game in 23.6 minutes of action
- He has reached double figures in scoring in seven games, including a season-high 23 points vs. Missouri State (11/30/13) and a team-leading 16 vs. Northern lowa (12/21/13), 14 points vs. Norfolk State (12/23/13) and 11 at Tennessee (12/30/13).
- Anderson also earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors after averaging 12 points in four wins during the tournament.
- He was one of two players in NCAA Divison I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.
- Anderson tallied 24 points, six rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in Virginia's season-ending 75-64 loss to lowa (3/27/13), while Ammons had 21 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers vs. FIU.

#### MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging 9.5 points, 5.4 rebounds and a team-leading 1.2 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 35.6 percent (16-of-45) from 3-point range and a team-leading 90.6 percent (29-of-32) from the free throw line.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and Green Bay (12/7/13) and matched his career high with three 3-pointers against JMU (11/8/13) and Green Bay.
- Brogdon tallied a career-best four consecutive games of double figures scoring from Nov. 12-23.
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

#### TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...CAN DO IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey has shown the ability to be Virginia's go-to man, averaging 7.1 points, 4.8 rebounds and a team-leading 1.2 blocks per game.
- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey, who has started four games, has scored in double figures in five games.

#### **AG MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER**

- Redshirt sophomore Anthony Gill made his UVa debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.
- Gill has led UVa in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).

You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

#### **PHOTO CREDENTIALS**

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

#### PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

#### **INTERVIEWS**

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

#### **POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena.
